ľľľ	Workforce Diversity	As the project company has only one employee (its managing director), workforce diversity is not applicable.
	Safety Management	AOV has carried out the largest regional construction project ever. An important target for the project is to substantially reduce the number of traffic incidents and thereby reducing the suffering caused by injuries and death. The project tunnels have been upgraded to comply with highest safety standards. In 2018 the project only had 8 car accidents with minor injuries which is an improvement by more than 90% over the normal accident rate for this type of road in Norway. The project is incentivised by the Norway road director to operate with highest safety standards through an annual safety bonus payment.
异	Customer Engagement	The company has periodical operational client meetings and an annual strategical meeting with the client at national level, which meetings are attended by directors.
	Communities	The project company's managing director participated in a local government environmental meeting with developers of local community real estate development aiming to increase awareness on treatment of water runoff from sulphuric rock.
